The Lantern Community Objectives are:

- ◆ To provide a range of accommodation, workshops and social settings, staffed by highly motivated employees and volunteers able to support adults who have learning difficulties.
- ◆ To provide opportunities for adults with learning difficulties to meet and interact with a wide range of people within the security of the Lantern Community and to develop the skills to engage with the wider community, supporting people to build relationships and develop their confidence so that they can take a full and active role in society.
- ◆ To extend and develop the range and quality of the services offered in direct response to the needs of those adults with a learning disability.



During the last few years **The Lantern Community** has significantly developed both its residential and workshop facilities and now has 41 residents and 32 day placements, as well as over 70 employees.

This expansion has now resulted in a situation where we have outgrown our present facilities and we do not now have a **social centre** whereby we can come together for celebrations, festivals, plays and the many social events that help create our community.

Additionally, our residents would greatly benefit from a **social centre** where they can meet, socialise and interact with their friends as well as make their own refreshments, and relax.
